What is SIP?

SIP stands for Shabbos Incentive Program, and it's an awesome way to **win prizes**, have **yummy kiddushes**, and go on a **cool trip** in a few months... just by davening and learning in shul! All kids in **grades 1 through 8** are welcome. Keep reading!

What You Need To Do

- 1) Register.** You have to register to participate and to get your individualized name tabs, so tell your parents and get to it! **SIP starts Shabbos Parshas Tetzaveh, 2/28/15.** To register, email ShalomMShapiro@gmail.com with "SIP Registration" in the subject line.
- 2) Read This Flier.** Find out what fun stuff is headed your way and what you need to do to earn credit for each activity.
- 3) Participate.** Come to shul, pick your activities for the week, and start earning credit!

Incentives (The fun stuff)

Grand Trip Those who **earn enough points** for their grade level **before the end of May** will be entitled to a **free, super-fun trip**, like *Skyzone* or *Funplex*! **Trip at end of May/early June!**

Matmidim Kiddush Those who **participate in 5 activities** in a month will join Rabbi Shalom for a **cake and ice cream Kiddush** the following month!

Matmidim Fame Those who **participate in 5 activities** in a month will have their **names displayed in shul** the following month!

Weekly Raffle Raffles need no explanation! Non-muktzah items only.

How It Works

- A certain number of **points are needed in order to be entitled to the Grand Trip**, which will take place at the end of May or beginning of June. Raffles and Matmidim Kiddushes are not based on specific point values.
- A record will be kept of each kid's participation using **individualized name tabs** that you hand in to the leaders of the activities. Every Shabbat, you'll go to the designated volunteer(s) of the week to get a pack of name tabs. See the Activity Menu for details.
- The **Matmidim** program recognizes kids who have participated in at least 5 activities in a month. Specific point values do not matter.
- A **Raffle** will be held weekly. If you participate in at least one activity, you are entitled to one raffle ticket.

Activity Menu

1. **Shabbos Groups:** Be on time for your grade-appropriate group, cooperate, and participate. Give your name tab to the group leader.
2. **Finishing Up (boys):** Lead davening from Ein Kelokeynu to the end. Give your name tab to the Gabbai, Dr. Eric Klein.
3. **Parsha Group (girls):** Attend and participate in the Girls' Parsha Group. Give your name tab to the group leader.
4. **Mishna Class (boys):** Attend and participate in Simcha Reich's Mishna Class. Give your name tab to Simcha.
5. **New Page of Tefilla (girls):** Tackle a page in the siddur that you've never read before. Read it for an adult, like your parent or family friend, and come with that person to tell Rabbi Shalom about it!
6. **In Shul & Davening:** As it sounds! Come with an adult who can confirm your attendance to Rabbi Shalom. See below for the start time expected of your grade.
7. **Junior Gabbai (Boys Only)** – Assist with various functions of the gabbai, such as pointing out the correct sefer Torah and helping those doing Hagba and Gelila. Give your name tab to the Gabbai, Dr. Eric Klein.
8. **Junior Sisterhood (Girls Only)** – Have fun helping the Sisterhood women prepare the Kiddush. Give your name tab to Mrs. Sylvia Levine.
9. **Parsha Chat with Rabbi Shalom:** Tell Rabbi Shalom something you learned about the week's parsha. It could be something you learned in school, at home, or anywhere!
